



Texas 4-H Foundation County Grant Program Rules & Guidelines 2024

Purpose

The purpose of this program is to provide funding to County and District 4-H Programming. These funds may be used to enhance (equipment purchases, education/training, events, etc.) existing 4-H programs and projects or to start new 4-H programs or projects.

Application Process/Rules

- The applications will open October 1st and the deadline to submit applications is 11:59 pm on December 31st.
- You must submit the application through our portal, [Grant Portal](#).
- If you do not already have an account set up in the portal, you will need to create one.
- The application will ask for a description of how the funds will be used, what problem the funds will be used to address, about your intended audience, a budget, and how you will evaluate the program.
- You will be notified if you did or did not receive a grant in February.
- If you receive a grant, the [funds must be used by August 31, 2026](#).
- You must email a one-page summary including 3 pictures to bailee.wright@ag.tamu.edu by August 31, 2026. More information regarding the summary will be sent to those who receive the grant.

FAQ's

Q: How do I get my grant funds?

A: The money you receive will be placed into your Texas 4-H Foundation account. You will receive monthly balance statements. [This is a reimbursement grant! You must turn in receipts or](#)

[invoices to the Texas 4-H Foundation to be reimbursed out of the grant funds](#). These receipts or invoices must be accompanied by a payment request form and submitted through Formsite. Those resources and links can be found here: [County & District Resources](#).

Q: Can I apply for multiple grants?

A: Yes, you may fill out a grant application for multiple project/program areas. However, you will not receive multiple grants. Only one may be selected to receive a grant. *Ex: Lubbock County submits a grant application for a Robotics Project and a separate grant application for an Archery Project. At max, Lubbock County would receive one grant for one of those two projects.*

Q: My county received a Texas 4-H Foundation grant last year; can we still apply for another grant this year?

A: Yes, absolutely!

Q: Where does this grant money come from?

A: The funds for these grants are raised by our Foundation Development Districts and the generosity of our donors. Each FDD hosts an annual fundraiser in order to be able to give these grants!
